## How do we pray?

Well, praying is simple. It's like sending an SMS but instead of using your phone, you use your heart. It's like writing an email but instead of using the internet, you use your heart. **Step 1:** When you pray, address who you are praying to.

**Step 2:** You can speak to God in any language. Just pick a language that you are familiar with. God can understand any language, even broken English.

**Step 3:** Keep it short and simple. Get straight to the point. Don't use big words.

**Step 4:** Ask God specifically. Ask Him how, who, what and even when.

**Step 5:** Be respectful. God loves you but be polite, respectful.

**Step 6:** End your prayer with, "In Jesus' name I pray, Amen".

**Step 7:** Listen, don't just pray. Remember to listen after praying.

## Here are some reference prayers:

*"Dear God, thank You for placing me here to make a difference. Please show or tell me how I can be a blessing to someone today. In Jesus' name, Amen."*

*"Dear Lord, please show us what we need to do this week or today to encourage, to bless or to help our friend, our colleagues, our teachers, our boss or our neighbours. In Jesus' name, Amen."*

*“Dear Lord, we want to be a blessing to the people around us just as You’ve called us to be. Please tell us what we need to do today or this week to bless, to encourage or to help our friends, our colleagues, our teachers, our bosses or even neighbours. In Jesus’ name, Amen.”*

*“Dear God, please teach or show me how I should share Your love with someone this week so they may know You better. In Jesus’ name, Amen.”*

## Praying in your Revo Groups

**When to pray?** We encourage all Revo Groups to choose a time that is not only where you can pray once but consistently and continuously. It could be before school, or after school, during lunch time if you’re working or if you’re studying in a college, anytime that happens to be free for most of your group. So don’t just choose one time, choose a time that works every time.

**Where to pray?** Well, we encourage all Revo Groups to pray in a location in which they choose to impact. For example, if you are a school student, we encourage you to pray on school grounds. If you are a campus student, then on campus. If you’re working, in your office building. It doesn't have to be public unless the Holy Spirit impresses on you to go out and be seen.
