(A) MATERIAL:

Read 2 Samuel 12:7-13

Talk it Out

- King David admitted his mistakes by simply saying "I have sinned". Why didn't David defend himself?
- A broken spirit and a contrite heart, God will not despise. What do you do to make things right to atone (make restitution) for his mistakes? (12:16-23)
- Have we ever made mistakes in our school? Do we repent immediately or do we try to talk our way out of it?

(B) MISSION:

Let's put faith into action.
