## Jeremiah Part 2: Rejected

### (A) MATERIAL:

Read Jeremiah 7:23-27, 36:23, 43:2

### Talk it Out

- Jeremiah was the mouthpiece of God, sometimes having to bring harsh words to the people, in hopes that they would repent from their evil ways and turn to God. But the people still did not listen to him (and ultimately God).
- How would you have felt if you were Jeremiah? Have you gone through a similar experience as Jeremiah and what was it like?
- As a Revolutionary, sometimes others (including Christians) may reject you and be hostile towards you. What would be your response?

### (B) MISSION:

If we read the whole book of Jeremiah, we see that Jeremiah still continued his same God-given message to the people. Just like Jeremiah, we are to continue giving the same God-given message to our people. Keep telling people about Jesus **TODAY!**

### (C) PRAYER:

Heavenly Father, I feel so rejected sometimes when my Christian friends think I am weird for doing RR. I feel so sad as well for them that they do not have the desire to see a change in our school through your name. God, please give me patience and strength to continue on.
