(A) MATERIAL:

Read Jeremiah 39:11-18

Talk it Out

- There are multiple times where Jeremiah had been rescued by God. In chapter 38, we see that Jeremiah is rescued from the cistern by Ethiopian guards. Jeremiah's own King, Zedekiah threatened to kill him. How would you feel?
- Jeremiah was rescued by Nebuchadnezzar, King of Babylon, supposedly the enemy of Judah. How would you have felt if you were Jeremiah, being rescued by your enemy?
- As a Revolutionary, you are doing good God's work just like Jeremiah but may encounter troubles along the way. God will always rescue His people, he never forsakes them.

(B) MISSION:

Our enemy is the evil one who always thwarts the plan of God. God never ceases to rescue us, just call upon him.
