# SAMSON

## Part 3: Conquer 'em

Temptations and trials are common to men. But we can be assured that we can overcome all these with God. If we are struggling in sin, we are to run to Jesus, He is our Help in need. In "Samson, Part 3," we learn from Samson's mistakes when he was pressured.

### (A) MATERIAL:

Read Judges 16:1-17

### Talk It Out:

- Samson is a man with great gifts in him but unfortunately, he never learned how to master himself (nature). As you know, we as Christians need to take a moment to learn where our weaknesses are. How are we dealing with it? Samson dealt with a lot of consequences because he gave into his weaknesses.
- Are we taking an initiative to **conquer our weaknesses** before ministering to others? Do we need to? Samson lost his gift just because he revealed the secret of his strength to Delilah and disobeyed God while at it (Read again verse 17)
- God wants us to overcome the weaknesses because he doesn't want us to fall.

### (B) MISSION:

So, here is a suggestion, you can actually **write down your weaknesses** on a paper or something and pass it to someone who you trust and more mature. So that, the person will **guide you through as you are accountable to him or her**. This is being done because we want you to come out of your comfort zone and the person will help you to overcome the areas you are weak at.. *I know it's hard for you to reveal your weaknesses but it takes your choice and courage to see your future shine.*

To conquer them, we need to feed our spirit with prayer as well. So, why don't you organize a Prayer Walk during recess? Walk to different areas of your school and you can start with the "Bilik Guru", Library, Canteen etc. and pray that God will save the souls in there and turn that place to a Prayer Ground one day.

**(C) PRAYER:**

Lord, please bless me with someone who I can be accountable with and help me to open up to him/her as well. Help me to take the courage and boldness to overcome the issues in my life and to listen to what You are saying through him/her. I pray in Jesus Name, Amen.
