Moses

Part 3: United We Stand

Functioning in teams can be challenging but more hands make light work. In the Bible, God used His people and Jesus had His disciples. In "Moses, Part 3", we see how God starts to build a structure for Moses to lead productively by including His people.

(A) MATERIAL:

Read Exodus 18:13-27

Talk it Out

- Moses was advised by Jethro, his father-in-law, to ask for other people's help in some of his tasks. If you were Moses, would you take his advice?
- Had Moses followed Jethro's advice, what are some of the pros and cons that he would have to deal with, allowing his followers to take up some of his duties? (eg. He will not burn out so easily or his followers might do the tasks wrong)
- In school, it is not wrong or 'uncool' to ask someone for help! What are some duties/tasks that you have been given, and feel that you cannot do it alone? Do not be afraid to ask for a helping hand!

(B) MISSION:

God made us different from one another. Some people, if not most, are too proud to ask for a helping hand, even though they would really appreciate one! It's up to YOU to extend that hand, and most of the time the person on the receiving end would be happy and blessed to receive it!

NEXT WEEK, make it an effort to help *someone in need!* It could be helping the canteen workers to **clean up** the canteen, or **helping a teacher** to carry her books! If they ask why, just say that you want to *bless them with the love of God!*

(C) PRAYER:

Dear Lord, please remind us Recess Revolutionaries that we are never alone in our walk with You. Teach us to care for one another and be there to guide and love our friends in school just as you have done for us. In Jesus name, Amen!
