## Moses

### Part 4: The Power of Forgiveness

It is never too late to say, "I am sorry." It forms the bridge that was once broken. As Revolutionaries, we are called to be the person who takes the first step. We see in "Moses, Part 4", how Moses seeks to bring reconciliation between the people and God.

#### (A) MATERIAL:

Read Exodus 32:1-14

#### Talk it Out

- The event of the Golden Calf shows how Moses forgave the people he was leading and asked God not to punish them for their disobedience. Moses had every right to feel hurt and angry. Yet, he chose to be the better man and forgave them.
- In our lives, we are sure to have some people whom we are angry/disappointed at for some particular reason. What could they be? (Betrayed your trust, lied to you etc)
- How can we, like Moses, forgive these people for what they've done to you?

#### (B) MISSION:

God always teaches us to be slow to anger and quick to forgive. Just as God forgave us of our sins, we should forgive others as well! It takes a little bit of courage and humility to step out and say 'sorry', but you will feel much better after!

**Next week**, there are 2 things that you should do. Number one, why not go **to someone** that you have hurt in the past, and sincerely **apologize** to them for what you've done. Secondly, why not go to someone who has hurt you in the past and forgive them! **Ask** the Holy Spirit for guidance, and **pray** that He will give you the right words to say!

#### (C) PRAYER:

Dear Lord, please teach us Recess Revolutionaries to be quick to forgive our friends just like how You have forgiven us from all our sins by dying on the Cross for us. Help us to let go of anger and unforgiveness, so that we can continue to shine for You in our schools. In Jesus name, Amen!
