King Saul Part 2: Did it My Way

We are our own god, always wanting to be independent and make our own decisions. "I did it because I just felt like it or because I wanted to". We have a choice in obeying God, but what is stopping you from obeying him? In "King Saul, Part 2", we see what Saul does.

(A) MATERIAL:

Read 1 Samuel 13:8-15, 14:36-46

Talk it Out

- Fear creeps in and causes doubt in your head about what God said. Saul was starting to place his confidence in his pride instead of God. He was probably fearful that he would lose his people. Have you ever felt that fear? Share what happened in that moment.
- Saul knew God's command but still went ahead. On another occasion, Saul did not listen or wait for God's instruction but went ahead with his plans. When are you tempted to do the same?
- Are there times where you forsake others for your own plan?

(B) MISSION:

Don't jump the gun. If God is not answering you, continue to wait upon him. God knows our hearts.

TODAY, allow God to speak to you and wait upon him. Take them to sit and listen to his voice and ask him what are his plans for RR. If God is asking you to do something now, do it, whether it is praying, walking or sharing the gospel.

(C) PRAYER:

Dear God, let us be patient. Your word tells us that strength will rise as we wait upon you. God, I do not want to take things into my own hands but be waiting upon your instructions. I want to seek you more and more. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen.
